Year 4 Manchester Camerata Experience

For the last three days, the children in Year 4 have been working with a small team of actors, musicians and composers to create, choreograph, rehearse and perform a piece of drama (featuring a song that they have written), which they will be showcasing at The Brindley Theatre on 5th June.

Four schools in Cheshire – one from Halton (us), one from Warrington, one from Cheshire East and one from Cheshire West & Chester – have been selected to work with The Manchester Camerata to create a special performance – commissioned by Cheshire Fire & Rescue – to inform people about the importance of keeping safe in the home, near water and in the community.

This project, titled 'Safer Together', will feature our Year 4 pupils highlighting how antisocial behaviour affects different members of a local community; and demonstrates how residents can come together to transform and change where they live for the better.

All pupils who are taking part will receive two free tickets to pass on to members of their family, who are invited to come along and watch them appear on stage. However, if anybody else would like to request a ticket to watch the performance, please inform Miss Smith or Miss Simcock in the school office, who will be able to reserve a ticket for you.

The plans for our 'Street Party' on Friday are well underway.



All of the children are invited to come to school dressed in red, white and/or blue on the day – but it is important for them all to wear sensible footwear that will enable them to take part in games on the school field, run around on the playground and dance in the school hall.

If your child does not usually have a school dinner but would like to be served a Summer Picnic on 18th May, it is not too late to order one. Simply inform the school office (and make a

We will store the blankets in crates outside each classroom – so they do not get mixed up – and it will be straight-forward to 'reunite' each blanket with their rightful owner at the end of the day.
