All of the children in Castle are invited to come into school on Monday, dressed in their own clothes - out of uniform - hopefully adorning something that is blue to signify their victory.

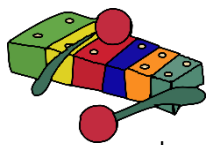
Friends Of Halton Lodge School (FOHLS)

Year 5 Chemistry With Cabbage



The children in Year 5 have had a particularly busy week, as yesterday the children were visited by a scientist called Rachel who led them through a series of science investigations.

The first of these was to use red cabbage to create an indicator solution to test a series of household products; to determine which were acidic, which were alkaline and which were neutral.

After discussing the observations that they had made, the children undertook a series of other scientific investigations and learned lots of new scientific vocabulary.

The children in Year 5 were praised for their excellent behaviour and enthusiasm by Rachel – who was keen to return to our school next year!
