- **Family Forest Schools Club** (for all year groups – but all children must be accompanied by an adult) on Tuesdays from 3:20pm to 4:30pm.
- **Infant Football Club** (for pupils in Year R to Year 3) on Tuesdays (from 3:10pm to 4:15pm).
- **Junior Football Club** (for pupils in Year 3 to Year 6) on Wednesdays (from 3:10pm to 4:15pm).
- **Junior Dodgeball and Benchball Club** (for pupils in Year 3 to Year 6) on Thursdays (from 3:10pm to 4:15pm).

All clubs cost just £1 each week to attend - and places can be reserved by filling in a consent form and making the necessary payment at the school office at any time.

Royal British Legion – Poppy Quest Appeal

Last summer, in Liverpool, the Royal British Legion held a Poppy Walk (for the second year running), and this year they are holding the event again, but under a new name "Poppy Quest".

Poppy Quest Liverpool is the perfect way to discover more about the past and present of this historic city. The 10km sponsored walk is suitable for all ages and abilities. You can walk solo, with your dog or with family and friends - it's completely up to you.

On setting off from the Williamson Square, you'll be armed with a map to navigate the trail with a set of questions to answer en route - which will get you to explore the city's rich history. For the kids, they'll each get a stamp collection card so, when they get to each question spot, they'll be encouraged to speak to one of the volunteers to find out more and receive their stamp reward.

Each adult is asked to fundraise £50 **but children can take part for free.** However, if you reach £100 in sponsorship you'll also receive a special prize for you or your team. The vital funds you raise will mean the Royal British Legion are able to support veterans and their families.
